Brioche has been the new skill to learn this Winter, and a number of you have done amazing work! We hope you all had a safe trip back home.



Come learn how to use the new, improved, easier knitCompanion for the iPad on Wednesday, April 11th at 11 AM. This new iPad app makes managing your knitting patterns a breeze. No need to crop text or charts if you just want to knit. Easier cropping and set-up if you want to use special counters and rows. Now, there are even repeat counters for text patterns. Please bring your charged iPad, Apple Id and password, and Ravelry Id and password. It would be great if you could have the new knitCompanion already installed and any

current projects exported to Dropbox, if you are a current knitCompanion user, before class. Kathleen can help with this, if you need help. You do not have to be a current user of knitCompanion to attend this class. (\$20)

Ready to do more with the new knitCompanion Next Gen? On Monday April 16<sup>th</sup> at 1:30 PM Kathleen will be teaching how to use knitCompanion Next Gen with magic markers, repeats, guided charts, and linked counters. The new knitCompanion Next Gen for iPad also has great new features for text patterns. We can finally use repeat counters with written patterns. If you are comfortable with knitCompanion for iPad, or took the basic knitCompanion Next Gen class, then you are ready for this class. Just bring your charged iPad. This class is also twenty dollars. Level KAL. The basic Knit  
Stitch & Purl Stitch are  
the only stitches used.

Worsted version, which  
calls for 630 yards. Molly

has selected Vintage from Berroco- which means 3  
skeins. We'll be using Size 8 needles 32 inches in  
length.

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## Fractal Danger KAL

Join Molly to knit this Shawlette on April 20th, April 27th, May 4th & May 11th from 11-1.

This should be a fairly quick and easy knit for most of you.

420-440 yards of Fingering/Sock yarn and pattern calls for size 4 US needles.

“This shawlette resembles an alien battle instrument, but will behave peacefully, warm and beautifully when wrapped around your neck and shoulders! The design features a long triangular shape that repeats itself (like a fractal form that can be found in nature – and mathematics), creating a unique shape that will wear very comfortably, can be draped in lots of interesting ways and make you look dangerously beautiful.”



Total length: 66 inches / 166 cm

Depth at widest point: 8 inches / 20 cm
