This shawl has an unique shape and the contrast of the lace work and the garter sections really work well together. So join me to knit this interesting shawl. We'll meet on *Tuesday's from 11–1 beginning January 16th–February 13th.*This project uses *2 skeins of sock yarn* and I have selected *Tosh Merino Light*. We'll be using size <u>US 5 & US 4</u> needles. Pattern is both written and charted and tassels are optional.
Knit–N–Purl recently got in a large shipment of this yarn so get your colorway asap.

New York Cardigan KAL

Join us Friday's beginning January 5 through February 9 to knit this beautiful cardigan. There were many requirements for this KAL and this garment met them all. It can be easily modified in several sections. We're thinking 6 weeks will be enough to finish this garment.

This pattern calls for *DK yarn and uses size US 9*, and *US 7 needles*.

Molly has narrowed yarns down to *Summer Silk from Berroco, Hampton from Cascade & Fiora from Berroco.* All of these would be excellent choices. Stop by Knit-N-Purl and see what works for you. These are all comparable in price.

Adult Surprise Jacket w/Arlene

Many of us have made the Baby Surprise Jacket with the intention of one day knitting the Adult Surprise Jacket. Well, the time has come. For all of you who have made the BSJ, we have found a ASJ calculator on School House Press that creates a pattern for you when you put in the desired measurements. (And of course, there is a CSJ – children)! We do not want to bombard you all with so many KALs at one time; however, this jacket will also start in late January and continue through February. This one won't be as difficult since you know what to expect, but it is for an adult or a child and will take time.

It is important that you know the exact measurement for the person for whom you are making this jacket!.

We will knit on Mondays beginning with January 22 and continue through the end of February – on Mondays only between 2 PM and 4 PM.





You can buy this pattern for \$5 directly from Molly Conroy on her Ravelry page, or from us in the store. She designed the bowl and bag for KnitCrate, a fabulous monthly knitting subscriptionompany.

For the pattern you need two highly contrasting colors. You need 2 skeins (440 yards) of the main color and 1 skein (220 yards) of the contrast color.

The worsted weight yarn is held double through out. If you choose to use bulky, cut the yardage in half. (two strands of worsted





weight hold together better actually felts better).

The color work is all done with slipped stitches. This is a very easy technique that will make your friends think you worked really hard! You only have to knit with one color per round.

This KAL is in two parts: the first is the knitting of the two objects: the bowl and the bag. The second part, for those of you who do not know how to felt, can get a felting lesson. We will have the sign up for the felting class on our website soon; it will have a minimal charge for the use of the shops machine and instruction time. We will also have a short class on learning how to sew in a zipper for the bag after it is felted. You will need to know Fair Isle for this KAL.

This KAL will be on Sundays in January, most of this knitting can be done in class to free you up for other knitting at home. We will start January 7 at 2 PM and knit till 4 PM (or longer if you can stay)!
