Join Martina and knit this exquisite shawl! We will meet on Wednesday starting February 7th for 5 weeks, ending on March 7th. 2pm-4pm. We are using a new yarn from Urth yarns. You will need 2 skeins of Uneek in a variegated and one skein of Harvest in a solid/semi-solid.

This is a fun shawl using short rows to give this a great effect. You can use w&t's or German short row method, Martina will go over both during the first day.



Pedenza

PENDENZA: Side to Side Jacket KAL

Join Molly Thursday's in March from 1-3 to knit this very simple garment using Plymouth's Pedenza 100% Egyptian Cotton -Mercerized which has 240 yards. We'll start on March 1st and end on the 29th. Pattern calls for size 6 needles and using 5-7 skeins of this yarn. You may order your colorway anytime before February 14th to make sure you get your yarn in plenty of time.

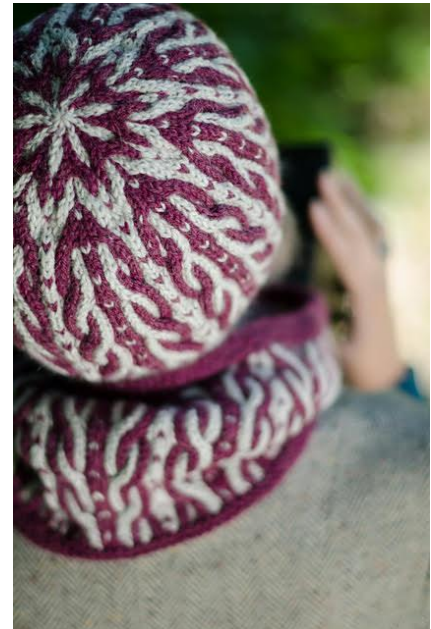


[Pentucket Hat](#)

It's time we all learned 2 Color Cables! Join Molly to make this gorgeous hat from Juniper Moon Farms using 2 colors of Herriot. We'll be using Size 4 & [6 US 16](#) inch needles and size 6 US Double Points to make this hat. Those of you who love Magic Loop will be fine with 40 inch needles. Pattern is available in the shop and is \$5.99. We'll begin on Tuesday, February 20th from 11-1pm, and we'll meet for 3 consecutive Tuesday's ending on March 6th.

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Fair Isle Sheep Bag

Join Molly to knit this precious Fair-Isle Sheep Bag. Pattern calls for a Worsted Yarn and we'll be using Berroco Vintage Worsted. 4 colors 1 skein each color. Size US 6 Needle 24 inches. Are you tired of not being able to fix your own mistakes? I promise you will feel better after this class. Now I cannot promise that you'll never make a mistake again, but I can help arm you with some basic knowledge and tools to make fixing your mistakes possible.

In this 2 hour class we will cover the following topics:

- Picking Up Dropped Stitches-in Stockinette & Garter
- "Reading" your work and why this is vital to your knitting success
- Ripping Back vs. Tinking Back
- Yarn Over's -yep they are usually the problem
- How markers can save your project
- Lifelines- planned & Afterthought

Materials to bring to class:

Worsted yarn- light in color and not varigated

Size 6 or 7 needles- circular 24 inch

Small crochet hook, locking markers, split-ring markers, tapestry needle
