Beginning Cable Class Saturday, March 24th from 10:30-12:30



This is the perfect class to get you started on cables. I love the Irish Hiking Scarf pattern and it's repetitive, which makes it the perfect beginner cable project. In this 2-hour class you'll learn a basic cable and then finish the scarf on your own. Pattern and tic sheet will be given out in the class.

Materials:

400 yards of Worsted Yarn– solid or heathered– no varigated recommended yarns: Cascade 220, Ultra Alpaca, Encore and many others...size US 8 circular needle Cable Needle– I prefer wood, but we can get you

started using any cable needle.

In this class you will knit a swatch and purposely make specific mistakes and then learn how to fix those mistakes. You will be correcting mistakes made by your classmates so you can learn to recognize the mistake and determine how to fix it.

In this 2-hour class we will deal with the following knitting issues:

- Dropped Stitches
- Elongated Stitches
- Twisted Stitches
- TINKing
- Pulling out multiple rows

Required Skills:

- Knit & Purl
- Cast -on

Supplies Needed:

- You will need Size 7 or 8 needles
- basic Crochet hook (can be purchased at class)

Cost is \$20 (2 hours).
