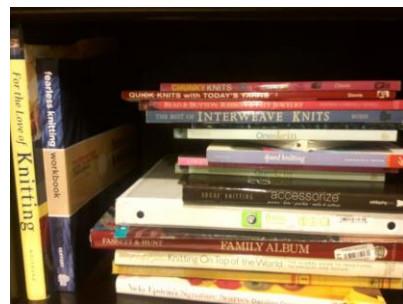


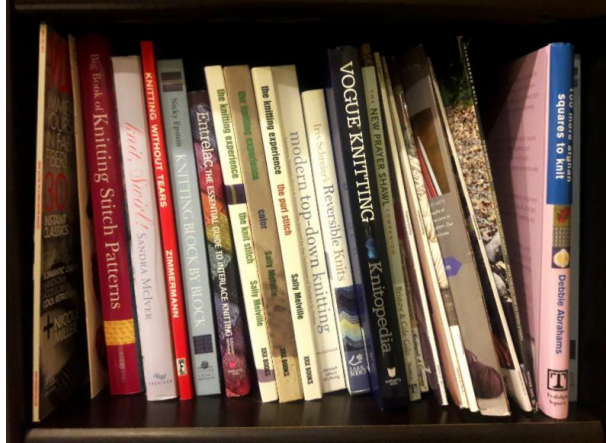

In this class you will knit a swatch and purposely make specific mistakes and then learn how to fix those mistakes. You will be correcting mistakes made by your classmates so you can learn to recognize the mistake and determine how to fix it.

In this 2-hour class we will deal with the following knitting issues:

- Dropped Stitches
- Elongated Stitches
- Twisted Stitches
- TINKing
- Pulling out multiple rows

Required Skills:

- Knit & Purl
- Cast -on

Supplies Needed:

- You will need Size 7 or 8 needles
- Lighter in Color Worsted Yarn
- Magic Fix-It Tool- Crochet hook (can be purchased at class)

Bring a skein of yarn you want to stash.

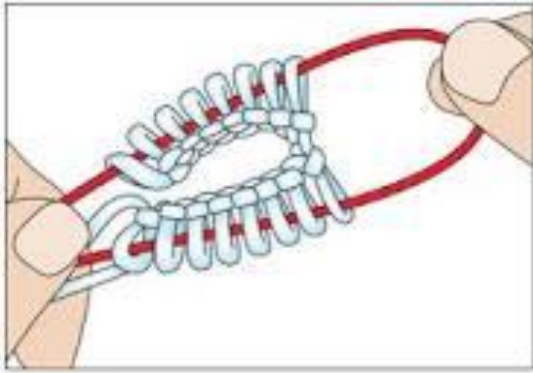
Bring a book you’d like to add to your library.
