Dance of the Hours by Sara Burch



Here is Nancy Jo wearing this gorgeous cowl. Martina has a KAL November 16th-30th 11-1.

Join Martina for 3 weeks to knit this interesting cowl and check off another lucky person on your gift list. Please get your supplies and gauge complete before the start of the KAL. Texture. Cables. Stripes. Lace. This cowl has a little bit of everything, all dancing harmoniously together to make a totally addictive knit. The middle panel features two-color slipped stitch cabling, which looks impressive but is really simple to work, with only one color used at a time. This type of “cowlette” has the style of a shawl but is effortless to wear and has the benefit of using far less yarn, meaning you can spring for those small skeins of precious yarn.

SIZES: One size, measuring approximately 18.5” (47 cm) in circumference at the neck.

MATERIALS: 2 skeins of Nova (MC) and (CC)

US 5/ 3.75 mm, 24” (60 cm) circular needle, or size needed to obtain gauge

Stitch markers, Cable needle, Yarn needle

GAUGE: 22 sts x 36 rows in 4” (10 cm) in stockinette st (note: exact gauge is not critical but may affect yarn usage)

NOTE: This pattern requires the use of charts.

We all make them — now learn how to fix them

In this class you will knit a swatch and purposely make specific mistakes and then learn how to fix those mistakes. You will be correcting mistakes made by your classmates so you can learn to recognize the mistake and determine how to fix it.

In this 2-hour class we will deal with the following knitting issues:

- Dropped Stitches · Elongated Stitches
- Twisted Stitches TINKing
- Pulling out multiple rows

Required Skills:

- Knit & Purl Cast -on

Supplies Needed:

- You will need Size 7 or 8 needles
- basic Crochet hook (can be purchased at class)

Cost is \$20 (2 hours).
