## Yarn of the month...



Silky Lace is a silky shiny yarn available in soft colours. A fabulous yarn for making comfortable autumn jumpers and light weight women's jackets. The warm blend of silk and merino makes it an ideal choice for warm shawls.



Each ball weighs 50 grams and has 260 meters. This is a fine weight yarn and we recommend using size 3-4 (U.S.)/(3-3.5 mm) knitting needles and size C2 (U.S.)/(2.5 mm) crochet hook. Machine wash up to 30°C on a wool cycle. Do not tumble dry.
