Cascade 220 Worsted is 100% wool and can be used for a plethora of projects, ranging from felted accessories to garments. One hank

has 220 yards (201 meters) of 100% Peruvian Highland Wool, 100 grams (3.53 oz), 18 – 20 sts. in 4 inches, US 7 – 8 needle (4.5 – 5 mm).

The Chimney Christmas Stocking

Martina will be leading this KAL beginning September 19th. This pattern uses slip stitches to make the red brick; an icord completes the top cinched with a bow and bells. She will take three weeks to finish this project: September 19, 26, and October 3. The KAL will be 11 AM – 1 PM.

Magic Loop



Molly says...

I know we all love Ravelry, and we don't always use all the aspects of it because of time constraints. So, I want to share a "quicker" way for you to add a Project. When I first was learning how to use Ravelry, I would start with adding a New Project and then looking for my pattern. Later I found a faster way to add projects. Go to the Pattern Page and pull up the pattern for your project. Look to the right of your page and click on "Cast on Project".



Then you can add in the details, but at least it's started. I also recommend that you add 1 photo—even if it's just a pic of your yarn and needles. Just be careful and don't post a paid pattern page so that the designer won't lose a sale. I try to arrange the yarn over the pattern with just the front photo and name showing. If you are struggling with learning Ravelry, call the shop and join a class. I have a Beginner class and a more advanced class.
